1. The meeting was called to order at 6:13pm

Melissa is looking into a student co-op that would enable someone to build an app for us and they would receive funding for post secondary tuition. She is going to investigate this and report back in November.

8. Movie – Erin Day made a motion for up to \$300 to spend on the concession for this event, with Lisa Al-Hoffmann seconding this. We have tentatively rescheduled for November 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup>. And we will be sticking to ring pops/chocolate bars/chips and small waters.
9. Recycling – Erin Day will be taking this over permanently at this time.
10. Meeting Ideas- Melissa will bring these to the November meeting, there were some suggestions made from our table at the Back to School BBQ.
11. Christmas Paint volunteers – Andrea Meding made a motion for up to \$1000, seconded by Lisa Al-Hoffmann, to cover supplies for this event. The money for the supplies for this event, as well as profits raised will be from the Fall Fundraiser account. Instead of a whole class participating, the teacher will be asking for volunteers. We will set up a room (tentatively November 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>) for 2 days, and the teachers will bring the students down with the volunteers staying in that area for the day (4hr shifts) to help. Students are welcome to paint whatever they would like, and the finished products will be displayed at the Christmas Concert on tables and parents will have first priority to buy their child's art. We will be setting up an online link so that parents can pay there instead of in person. Andrea & Kristen will be there Thursday and Melissa and Trisha will be there Friday.
